Sebastian River High School Band Scholarship Criteria

Eligibility

- Student participation in band for all four years of high school
- Minimum GPA of 3.0 (include a copy of your current transcript or Counselor Recommendation Form with your application)
- Student must continue study of music, dance, or flags at the collegiate level for at least one semester. (You **do not** have to major or minor in music or dance)

Application Deadline

Application must be postmarked no later than the Friday before Spring Break.

Application Process

- Submit a completed application
- Include two (2) non-family member letters of recommendation
- Prepare an essay addressing the influence that the music program has made on you. The essay should be typed, double-spaced, and a minimum of two (2) pages.

Award Process

A panel of Community Leaders will review the applications and award points for the following:

- 40 points – Musical Honors/Activities
- 30 points – Non-Musical Honors/Activities
- 30 Points – Essay

Applicants may be asked for an interview in the event that the reviewers cannot make an award based solely on the application. ***Monies will be mailed to students after the start of their first semester of college. Students must provide a copy of their schedule reflecting at least one class of music or dance for one semester.***
