

UNIFORM ROOM

Gloves (\$5.00) will be sold in the band room before each performance. Blue Band Shirts (\$10.00) and Chaperone shirts are available in the Uniform Room.

RULES AND PROCEDURES

Uniform Pick-up

1. Enter QUIETLY from the OUTSIDE hall door.
2. Uniform and hat numbers are listed alphabetically inside the room on the wall to the right of the door.
3. Locate your uniform and hat box and remove them from their locations. If you can't find your number, ask for help. **DO NOT TAKE SOMEONE ELSE'S UNIFORM OR HAT!**
4. Exit QUIETLY through the INSIDE hall door.
5. Leave your uniform hanger and hat box in a safe location in the band room.

Uniform Return

1. Put your hat back in the box carefully.
2. Hang pants **NEATLY** on your hanger. Hold pants by the hems with the leg inseams together. The white stripes should be on the outside. Drape pants over the hanger bar.
3. Hang your jacket **NEATLY** with the hanger number facing the front of the jacket. Do not catch the hanger in the jacket lining. Make sure both sleeves are right side out. **LEAVE JACKET UNZIPPED.**

NOTE: DO NOT LEAVE ANYTHING IN THE JACKET POCKETS (jewelry, money, tissues, hairbands, reeds, etc.)

WE DO NOT CHECK POCKETS BEFORE SENDING UNIFORMS TO BE DRY-CLEANED!!!!!!

4. Line up in the outside hall in an orderly manner to enter the Uniform Room from the outside hall door.

5. When admitted, quietly replace your hat on the correct shelf and your uniform in numerical order on the bar you got it from. Make sure your pants and jacket are neat and hanging with the right shoulder (cord) out.

6. Exit through the inside hall door.

UNIFORM REPAIR SLIPS are to be filled out to notify the uniform volunteers of repairs needed to your uniform. **DO NOT WAIT UNTIL THE DAY BEFORE A PERFORMANCE TO DO THIS.** Please save any snaps or buttons that may fall off.

PLEASE HANDLE ALL UNIFORM PARTS CAREFULLY TO LIMIT THE NEED FOR REPAIRS AND TO EXTEND THE LIFE OF THE UNIFORM!!!!!!!
